

Hole 5 / Hole 4



Hole 5 - Notes:

- A. Lower the rear tee by 0.4m or so, so that it does not sit artificially high as a backdrop to the 4th green.
- B. Expand the 'summer' tee 4m forward and the 'winter' tee 6m or so.
- C. Grow the red tee 1m or so to the left
- D. Restore the rear bunkers as per the historical photo!
- E. Expand the green by 9-8ft behind the far-right bunker, capturing a particularly interesting and challenging hole location where the green slides away.
- F. Remove the build-up of sand on the fairway flanking lip of the existing bunkers, taking fairway cut tight to the new edge. Restore the right sided finger (as seen in the historical photo).
- G. Take the fairway taken further right, sweeping into/ across the right greenside bunkers.



Hole 4 - Notes:

- H. With the bunker no longer obscured by gorse, climb the sand line towards the heather line for added drama.
- I. Take the rear-left of the green tight towards the left bank, recapturing an interesting pin beyond a slight rise.
